



Memorandum of Confidentiality

This memorandum relates to disclosure to you of certain confidential information described below, including any information disclosed by CPRA/Geidankyo to you during the Term as defined below, that at the time of disclosure is confidential in nature or may reasonably be considered to be commercially sensitive.

You are permitted to use Confidential Information: “Playlist” and “Unclaimed Played Recordings” provided by CPRA/Geidankyo for making the recording claims on behalf of your clients (the Permitted Purpose).

For the period of two years (the Term) after the disclosure to you of the Confidential Information, you must not do any of the following without prior written consent:

1. To disclose any of the Confidential Information and related information obtained in course of duties to any third party, except your employees or professional advisers, and
2. To use the Confidential Information for anything outside the scope of the Permitted purpose.

The obligations of confidentiality will not apply if you can prove:

1. The Confidential Information has become public knowledge by a source that was not you or linked to you, or
2. The Confidential Information was already known to you prior to any disclosure from.

This Memorandum shall be governed by and interpreted according to the Law of Japan and all disputes arising under the Memorandum including non-contractual disputes or claims shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of Japan.
